Dear Dr. Cantwell,

The Office of Laboratory Animal Welfare (OLAW) acknowledges receipt of your June 20, 2020 letter reporting an incident of noncompliance with the PHS Policy on the Humane Care and Use of Laboratory Animals at the University of Arizona. Your letter supplements the preliminary report submitted on November 25, 2019. According to the information provided it is understood that on September 30, 2019 a PI used an unapproved drug and euthanasia method on a protocol involving mice. The PI voluntarily halted the activity. It was stated that the animal(s) were assigned to a PHS-funded activity.

The corrective and preventive actions consisted of the PI describing corrective measures that had been implemented to prevent recurrence of an incident of this nature. The measures included informing all research staff of the IACUC's requirement for securing approval for all procedures prior to work involving animals, as well as retraining of staff to ensure knowledge of protocol procedures. The PI assured the IACUC that all research staff will from now on carefully review and adhere to approved study protocols.

OLAW believes that the corrective and preventive measures put in place by the University of Arizona are consistent with the provisions of the PHS Policy on Humane Care and Use of Laboratory Animals. We appreciate being informed of this matter and find no cause for further action by this office.

The University of Arizona, in accordance with Assurance D16-00159 (A3248-01) and PHS Policy IV.F.3., provides this report of PI use of an unapproved drug and euthanasia method. This incident occurred on September 30, 2019.

The following corrective action plan was implemented after the incident:

- The PI voluntarily halted the activity
- The PI submitted correspondence to the IACUC, dated 12/6/19, expressing regret for the noncompliance incident and that the use of an unapproved drug and euthanasia method was an oversight.
- The PI described corrective measures that had been implemented to prevent recurrence of an incident of this nature. The measures included informing all research staff of the IACUC's requirement for securing approval for all procedures prior to work involving animals, as well as retraining of staff to ensure knowledge of protocol procedures
- The PI assured the IACUC that all research staff will from now on carefully review and adhere to approved study protocols.

At their meeting on 12/9/2019, the IACUC approved the corrective action plan implemented by the PL.


