This report summarizes the IACUC's results of its most recent program review and facility inspection, as required by the Public Health Service (PHS) Policy on Humane Care and Use of Laboratory Animals (Policy), Section IV.B.1.-3., the *Guide for the Care and Use of Laboratory Animals* (Guide), and the Animal Welfare Act (AWA) regulations, as applicable. Submission of semiannual reports to the Institutional Official is a condition of this Institution's Animal Welfare Assurance with the NIH Office of Laboratory Animal Welfare (OLAW).

I. Description of the Nature and Extent of the Institution's Adherence to the PHS Policy, the *Guide*, and the AWA:

The USDA APHIS National Wildlife Research Center (NWRC) in Fort Collins, CO was granted an OLAW Animal Welfare Assurance (#A4676-01) on August 14, 2012.

Based upon the semiannual facility inspection and semiannual program evaluation conducted for the period of October 1, 2015 through March 31, 2016, The NWRC Animal Facilities and Animal Care and Use Program appear to be in compliance with the PHS Policy, the *Guide for the Care and Use of Laboratory Animals*, and the Animal Welfare Regulations.

II. Deficiencies in the Institution's Animal Care and Use Program

The NWRC Animal Care and Use Program was evaluated using the OLAW Semiannual Program Review Checklist. The Animal Welfare Regulations require a minimum of two IACUC members are needed to complete the semiannual evaluation. The OLAW checklist was distributed to all members, and a total of six checklists were completed and returned by May 6, 2016.

No significant or minor deficiencies in the NWRC Animal Care and Use Program were identified on the OLAW checklists for the semiannual evaluation.

III. Deficiencies in the Institution's Animal Facilities (NWRC, Fort Collins, CO)

The NWRC Outdoor Animal Research Facility, Animal Research Building, and the Invasive Species Research Building at NWRC in Fort Collins, CO were inspected on February 12, 2016 by Kevin Bentler and Steve Greiner.

No significant or minor deficiencies of the NWRC animal facilities were identified during the inspection.







