Dear Dr. Gipson-Cosier,

The Office of Laboratory Animal Welfare (OLAW) acknowledges receipt of your July 11, 2018 letter reporting an instance of noncompliance with the PHS Policy on Humane Care and Use of Laboratory Animals at Tufts University & Tufts Medical Center, Boston Campus. According to the information provided, OLAW understands that an unauthorized researcher euthanized seven pregnant mice earlier than experimentally planned. This was done to negatively impact a Principal Investigator's research. It was not stated if the related protocol was, or was not, PHS funded.

Corrective actions included identifying the responsible researcher and revoking the researcher's animal facility access. Disciplinary action was initiated, and the researcher is no longer employed at Tufts University.

The prompt consideration of this unfortunate incident by Tufts University & Tufts Medical Center, Boston Campus was consistent with the philosophy of institutional self-regulation. OLAW concurs that the incident warranted reporting. Based on the information provided, OLAW is satisfied that appropriate actions have been taken to investigate this incident and prevent recurrence. We appreciate being informed of this matter and find no cause for further action by this office.

Dear Dr. Wolff:

We are writing to notify OLAW of the circumstances and actions taken with respect to the following issue of non-compliance, as required by the PHS Policy on Humane Care and Use of Laboratory Animals (section IV.F.3). The Tufts University (Boston Campus) Assurance number is A3775-01. The following issue of non-compliance occurred in the centralized animal facilities.

Seven pregnant mice were euthanized earlier than experimentally planned by an unauthorized researcher who admitted he caused the loss of the dams to negatively impact a Principal Investigator's research. Therefore, the animals were not utilized for the purpose that the IACUC had approved. The carcasses were left in the cages and found by other personnel; including researchers in the same lab and husbandry staff members.

The following actions were taken to investigate and resolve the issue:

- The Institutional Official, Principal Investigator, and Tufts Public Safety were notified.
- Public Safety initiated an investigation and was able to identify the researcher responsible.
- Once identified, animal facility access was revoked.
- Disciplinary action for the researcher was initiated with Human Resources. The researcher is no longer employed at Tufts University.

At an IACUC meeting, this issue was voted to be significant and therefore reportable to OLAW. This letter provides the summary of the issue and resolution to OLAW as voted by the IACUC. If you have any questions, please contact us. Thank you.
