The Office of Laboratory Animal Welfare (OLAW) acknowledges receipt of your October 5, 2018 letter reporting an instance of noncompliance with the PHS Policy on Humane Care and Use of Laboratory Animals at Tufts University. According to the information provided, OLAW understands that four mice failed to receive post-operative analgesia as per protocol, following osmotic pump implantation.

The corrective actions consisted of stopping additional surgeries, counseling the laboratory staff, ordering the appropriate analgesic, having the Principal Investigator (PI) retrain the students, and having the PI confer with the veterinary staff and collaborate with experienced surgeons at the institution.

OLAW understands that the protocol involved was not PHS-supported, but concurs that the incident was serious and supports the actions taken by the institution. The establishment and application of policies and practices that are consistent with the provisions of the PHS Policy at Tufts University are commendable and avoid the perception of a double standard. Thank you for informing OLAW about this matter.

Dear Dr. Wolff:

We are writing to notify OLAW of the circumstances and actions taken with respect to the following issue of non-compliance, as required by the PHS Policy on Humane Care and Use of Laboratory Animals (section IV.F.3). The Tufts University (Boston Campus) Assurance number is D16-00459 (A3775-01).

The following issue of non-compliance occurred under Dr. Nian-Qing Shi's IACUC protocol. Post-operative analgesia (one dose of Buprenorphine-SR) was not provided to four mice undergoing osmotic pump implantation, as required in the protocol.

Upon learning of the incident, Dr. Shi stopped all surgical activities while the situation was investigated. She discussed the situation with veterinary staff, the surgeon responsible, and the rest of the students in her lab. The PI immediately placed an order for the Buprenorphine SR and ordered a lock box to ensure proper storage of the controlled substance.

To prevent any future recurrences, the PI confirmed she would:

- Re-educate herself and her students on the mouse surgical protocol.
- Arrange additional meetings with DLAM veterinarians, if questions arise in the future.
- Explore a plan for future mouse surgeries with experienced surgeons in the Molecular Cardiology Research Institute (MCRI) at Tufts Medical Center.

At an IACUC meeting, the issue of non-compliance was voted to be significant and therefore reportable to OLAW. This letter provides a summary of the issue and resolution to OLAW as voted by the IACUC. There is no NIH funding for this research.
