 - While not technically a minority view, one IACUC member expressed a dissenting opinion regarding the pain classification of a study evaluating potential toxicants in coyotes upon viewing the procedure. The IACUC member in question approved this study, and the assigned pain classification, during Protocol Review, with no dissenting opinion.

The IACUC member communicated this dissenting opinion in the assigned pain classification to the IACUC Chair. It should be noted that the Attending Veterinarian was present to monitor animals during the entirety of the study in question. The IACUC will reassess pain classification criteria (and study appropriateness) if follow-up studies for the toxicants in question are proposed.
