I am writing to report the reinstatement of a **suspended animal protocol A17-045** at the University of Connecticut/ Storrs campus. The protocol is linked to the following NIH/NHLBI award # RO1HI1470282-01A1. The decision to lift the suspension was made at a fully convened IACUC meeting on January 8, 2020, after confirmation of completion of the required actions outlined by the IACUC in its letter of suspension to the Principal Investigator dated December 12, 2019.

The IACUC has notified the Principal Investigator that the protocol has been reinstated. The appropriate personnel in the Animal Care Services (ACS) facility, as well as Sponsored Program Services (SPS) have received a copy of that notice. SPS staff will notify the sponsor of reinstatement.
