The Office of Laboratory Animal Welfare (OLAW) acknowledges receipt of your August 26, 2019 letter reporting an instance of noncompliance with the PHS Policy on Humane Care and Use of Laboratory Animals at the University of Alabama at Birmingham. According to the information provided, OLAW understands that 75 mice which had undergone a survival surgical procedure were given a non-pharmaceutical grade analgesic. No adverse effects were noted with the mice.

The corrective actions consisted of stopping further surgeries until the appropriate analgesic was obtained. The Principal Investigator and staff were counseled on following institutional policies.

Based on its assessment of this explanation, OLAW understands that measures have been implemented to correct and prevent recurrence of this problem. OLAW concurs with the actions taken by the institution to comply with the PHS Policy.

Dear Dr. Morse:

Below is the description of unapproved deviations from the Guide for the Care and Use of Laboratory Animals and/or the PHS Policy identified and discussed at the July 31, 2019 IACUC full committee meeting. The incident of non-compliance was identified through post approval monitoring. Described corrective action for the incident is also included.

Failure to follow the IACUC/Institutional policy: A routine laboratory audit conducted by the Compliance Coordinator determined that approximately 75 mice had undergone a surgical procedure without providing a pharmaceutical grade analgesic. Animals were to receive pharmaceutical grade Buprenorphine for postoperative pain management, which was available for order; however, the audit discovered that the laboratory was using a non-pharmaceutical grade Buprenorphine instead of following the institutional policy. No adverse effects were noted in the animals' health status records, and all surgical procedures were halted until the correct pharmaceutical grade analgesic could be acquired. Corrective actions: The laboratory staff (including the PI) received counseling by the Compliance Coordinator on the importance of knowing and following the institutional policies related to the use of pharmaceutical grade compounds. This incident-involved work funded by NIH award RF1AG056815.
