Dear Dr. Lakin,

The Office of Laboratory Animal Welfare (OLAW) acknowledges receipt of your July 31, 2019 letter reporting an instance of noncompliance with the PHS Policy on Humane Care and Use of Laboratory Animals at the University of Colorado – Denver. According to the information provided, OLAW understands that a lead technician did not assign a daily health check to another technician when the usual technician called out sick. This resulted in a missed daily health check. No animal health issues were reported and no animals appeared to be adversely affected. Corrective actions included retraining of the lead technicians regarding reassignments when a technician calls out sick. It was not stated whether any of the animals involved were funded by the PHS or NSF.

The consideration of this matter by the University of Colorado – Denver was consistent with the philosophy of institutional self-regulation. Similarly, the action taken to prevent recurrence of the issue is appropriate. We appreciate being informed of this matter and find no cause for further action by this office at this time.

The Institutional Animal Care and Use Committee (IACUC) at the University of Colorado Denver | Anschutz Medical Campus received a report of a non-compliance regarding a missed daily health check.

Upon investigation by the Office of Laboratory Animal Resources it was determined that the lead technician did not assign the health check to another technician when the usual technician called out sick. No health issues were reported and no animals appeared to be adversely affected. Retraining of the lead technicians occurred regarding reassignments when a technician calls out sick.

At a convened meeting of a quorum of the IACUC, a majority of the quorum present determined to accept the corrective actions described above. The Committee determined further that the Office of Laboratory Animal Welfare (OLAW) be informed of this incident.
