The Office of Laboratory Animal Welfare (OLAW) acknowledges receipt of your September 26, 2019 letter reporting an instance of noncompliance with the PHS Policy on Humane Care and Use of Laboratory Animals at the University of Colorado – Denver. According to the information provided, OLAW understands that members of the animal care staff did not perform adequate routine health checks and as a result, two mice died due to no access to water. The animal care staff members were counseled and disciplined. It was not stated if the animal activity the animals were assigned to was funded by the PHS or the NSF.

The consideration of this matter by the University of Colorado – Denver was consistent with the philosophy of institutional self-regulation. Similarly, the action taken to prevent recurrence of the issue is appropriate. We appreciate being informed of this matter and find no cause for further action by this office at this time.

Dear Dr. Morse;

The Institutional Animal Care and Use Committee (IACUC) at the University of Colorado Denver | Anschutz Medical Campus received a report of an animal welfare incident involving the death of two mice due to no access to water.

Upon investigation by the Office of Laboratory Animal Resources it was determined that members of the animal care staff overlooked these during routine health checks and were counseled and disciplined according to OLAR policy.

At a convened meeting of a quorum of the IACUC, a majority of the quorum present determined that the animal care staff failed to monitor adequately animal health. The IACUC accepted the corrective actions described above. The Committee determined further that the Office of Laboratory Animal Welfare (OLAW) be informed of this incident.
