turther, I heard that DEA Controlled Substances were obtained in violation of University Policy and that Surgery records were inadequately documented, if at all documented. The unreported illegal Surgeries have been covered Up by the Stoff I was told.

I have also been made aware that prior USDA inspections have cited osu for inadequate Veterinary care and having inadequate outdoor facilities!

This Criminal activity is unacceptable. The lives of animals are in peril.

I demand the license of 050 for access to animals be revoked, and the animals moved to sanctuary, and relinguished by 050 immediately.
