I was made aware of the Oregon State University (OSU) animal laboratory performing Surgery under an expired protocol by a team of unapproved staff.

Further, I heard that DEA Controlled Substances were obtained in violation of University Policy and that Surgery records were inadequately documented, if at all documented. The unreported illegal Surgeries have been covered up by the staff I was told.

I ~~am~~^{have} also been made aware that prior USDA inspections have cited OSU for inadequate Veterinary care and having inadequate outdoor facilities.

This Criminal activity is unacceptable. The lives of animals are in peril.

I demand the license of OSU for access to animals be revoked, and the animals moved to Sanctuary, and relinquished by OSU immediately.
