Dear Dr. Hendricks,

The Office of Laboratory Animal Welfare (OLAW) acknowledges receipt of your February 24, 2020 letter reporting a serious deviation from the provisions of the Guide for the Care and Use of Laboratory Animals at Seattle Children's Research Institute, following up on an initial report on December 16, 2019. According to the information provided, OLAW understands that a dead mouse was found in a broken down cage in the dirty side of the cage wash. The responsible party could not be identified.

The corrective actions consisted of sending an email to all animal users stating that cages are to be checked for animals before sending them to cage wash. The matter was discussed by members of the Institutional Animal Care and Use Committee (IACUC), animal care staff, and research staff and advice was also sought through a national IACUC listsery.

Based on its assessment of this explanation, OLAW understands that measures have been implemented to reduce the likelihood of a recurrence of this problem. OLAW concurs with the actions taken by the IACUC to comply with the PHS Policy on Humane Care and Use of Laboratory Animals.

Dear OLAW,

This letter is to provide you with a full explanation of the circumstances and actions taken following an incident at our institution as required by PHS Policy IV.F.3.a.

The Institutional Animal Care and Use Committee (IACUC) office received information that one mouse was found dead in a broken-down cage in dirty cage wash.

To narrow down labs who may have been involved in the incident, the Office of Animal Care (OAC) compiled data regarding cage card barcodes submitted during the incident window. However, since nearly all labs with active protocols using the specific cages involved submitted cage card barcodes during the time window, specific labs could not be identified.

In response to the incident, the following corrective actions were implemented:

- The IACUC office sent out an email notice to all animal users to remind them to check cages prior to leaving them for dirty cage wash;
- A working group of IACUC office staff, OAC staff and researchers was formed to discuss possible additional corrective actions; and
- 3. The IACUC office queried a national IACUC listserv for other potential solutions to prevent recurrence and received two responses to share with the working group.

The incident has been reviewed by an IACUC Subcommittee and the convened IACUC. The IACUC accepted these corrective actions as being sufficient to prevent recurrence.
