## EXPLANATION FOR THE USE OF ANIMALS LISTED IN COLUMN E

Cattle were infected with *Theileria parva*, the cause of East Coast Fever. *Theileria parva* causes an inflammatory infectious disease, and our experimental design includes options to administer antiinflammatory drugs (e.g., banamine) to animals that develop fever and other signs of inflammation. The cattle identified as Column E did receive analgesics, and we do everything possible for these animals. However, the analgesics are not able to fully ameliorate fever, so we are reporting the animals in Column E.
