4. Explain the procedure producing pain and/or distress.

This protocol contains a standard model to test C. difficile infection and therapeutic usage. The model creates severe infection in which vehicle or low treated antibiotic control groups will be more likely to succumb. As death is NOT an endpoint, humane endpoints are put in place, however not all animals are caught by monitoring prior to becoming moribund.

In order to test the efficacy of therapeutics, an infection must be created. Treatment of the infection to alleviate pain and/or distress would not allow for valid screening of the therapeutic agent. A clinical assessment scoring is used to monitor all animals, thereby euthanizing animals that start to show signs of depression or lethargy.
