One animal died due to test article-related toxicity.

Administration of pain relieving drugs could have masked the potential "toxic" effects of the test compound. This was unavoidable in a "toxicity" study of this type.

One animal accidental death due to gavage error; animal died immediately after dosing.

Four animals died due to test article toxicity; administration of pain relieving drugs could interfere with study endpoints (i.e., survival). This was unavoidable in a "toxicity" study of this type.
