#### **Program Changes**

- Several policies and procedures were updated to better reflect or further clarify current requirements including: Humane Use Categorization (Pain Categories), Off-site Animal Use, Animal Transport, Rodent Surgery, Training and Continuing Education Requirements and Offsite Contracted Vertebrate Animal Activities. Procedures used to conduct VVC were discussed during the PHS Assurance renewal process during the months of October and November 2018. Following guidance received by OLAW, the PHS Assurance document was modified as it pertained to the VVC procedures followed by the UK IACUC. Following those changes, policy 112 was updated to reflect more accurately the updated requirements to conduct VVC. Additional references have been included and two categories previously listed: *Change of sample collection times (if not exceeding standard limits)* and *Change of non-invasive sampling (if not exceeding standard limits)* were consolidated under *Change to the duration, frequency, type or number of procedures performed on an animal.*

- 3) Animal Housing Facility program descriptions have been developed for all identified locations.
- 4) A new facility, the Healthy Kentucky Research Building, (previously known as RB2) is now in partial use (@ 6 rodent rooms) and will be included in the AAALAC annual report as a component of the accredited program of animal care and use. AAALAC will conduct a site visit to include this new site in the third trimester of 2020.
- 5) As discussed at the July 2019 IACUC meeting, the committee no longer takes a vote to approve semiannual reports to the IO.

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6) In accordance with NIH NOT-OD-15-139, effective October 1, 2015 the University of Kentucky covers NSF-supported vertebrate animal activities under its OLAW Animal Welfare Assurance (A-3336-01) and will promptly report situations involving NSF-supported animal activities to OLAW as required by the Public Health Service (PHS) Policy on Humane Care and Use of Laboratory Animals. ## Animal Welfare Assurance for Domestic Institutions
