Program Changes - UMD Animal Care and Use Program

There has been no change in AAALAC accreditation status: The University of Maryland is Category One (1) - accredited by the Association for Assessment and Accreditation of Laboratory Animal Care International (AAALAC) on October 26th, 2011. The most recent AAALAC triennial site visit took place on June 26th – 28th, 2017. The program received official word of continuing full accreditation on December 4th, 2017. The next accreditation site visit will occur in summer, 2020.

The University of Maryland assurance with the Public Health Service, **D16-00172 (A3270-01)**, was renewed in 2018 and became effective on **May 22nd, 2018**. Since that date, please note the following changes in the UMD Animal Care and Use Program, as described in the assurance, by section:

S. Army.

Authority: Dr. Shelton has direct program authority and responsibility for the institution's Animal Care and Use Program, including access to all animals. On-call veterinary support for the program is provided on a rotating basis, which includes Dr. Shelton, (b) (6), and any other UMD clinical veterinarian employed by and contributing to the Animal Care Program.
