The Office of Laboratory Animal Welfare (OLAW) acknowledges receipt of your letter dated January 14, 2020, concerning a report of an incident of noncompliance with the Public Health Service Policy on the Humane Care and Use of Laboratory Animals within the animal care and use program at the University of Iowa. According to the information provided, OLAW understands that on December 19, 2019, a mouse exceeded the number of days on an approved study protocol and was subsequently euthanized. This activity was PHS funded.

Corrective and preventive actions included amending the study protocol to extend the study duration.

The University of Iowa's prompt reporting of this incident was consistent with the philosophy of self-regulation. Similarly, the timely actions taken to respond to the issue were appropriate. We appreciate being informed of this matter and find no cause for further action by this office.

Dear Dr. Wolff:

This letter is to report an incident involving mice. The University of Iowa PHS Assurance Number is D16-00009 (A3021-01). The grant number affected is AI139874.

December 19, 2019: During veterinary review of a clinical case, it was determined that a mouse undergoing treatment had exceeded the study/experimental endpoint. Although the animal had not met clinical endpoints that would require euthanasia, the animal had exceeded the number of days on study as approved in the Animal Protocol. The mouse was subsequently euthanized.

The IACUC Office was promptly notified of the incident and the PI contacted. The PI was directed to submit appropriate amendments to allow for extension of the study duration and the PI has done so.

January 8, 2020: The IACUC members discussed the incident at a convened meeting and voted to report to the appropriate agencies.
