The Office of Laboratory Animal Welfare (OLAW) acknowledges receipt of your January 3, 2020 letter reporting an instance of noncompliance with the PHS Policy on Humane Care and Use of Laboratory Animals at The University of Iowa.

According to the information provided, OLAW understands that on November 18, 2019, an animal care technician flagged a cage of mice for follow-up with a veterinary technician, where upon it was discovered that mice had fight wounds. A laboratory member had combined cages of adult male mice which was not in accordance with IACUC Policy on Social Housing and subsequently, four mice where euthanized. The IACUC office and the PI were contacted promptly. The study was PHS supported.

As a corrective measure, the IACUC Training and Compliance Manger (ITCM) met with the lab member to provide retraining.

OLAW appreciates the prompt consideration of this matter by The University of Iowa which is consistent with the philosophy of institutional self-regulation. Based on the information provided, OLAW is satisfied that appropriate steps have been taken to investigate this incident and to attempt to prevent recurrence. Dear Dr. Wolff:

This letter is to report an incident involving mice. The University of Iowa PHS Assurance Number is D16-00009 (A3021-01). The grant number affected is AI127481.

November 19, 2019: An animal care technician flagged a cage of mice for veterinary follow up. Upon observation by a veterinary technician, it was found that mice had fight wounds. A lab member had combined cages of adult male mice which was not in accordance with IACUC Policy on Social Housing. Four mice were subsequently euthanized.

The IACUC Office was promptly notified of the incident and the PI contacted.

November 21, 2019: The IACUC Training and Compliance Manager met with the lab member to provide retraining.

December 11, 2019: The IACUC members discussed the incident at a convened meeting and voted to report to the appropriate agencies.
