Dear Dr. Cramer,

The Office of Laboratory Animal Welfare (OLAW) acknowledges receipt of your September 10, 2019 letter reporting an instance of noncompliance with the PHS Policy on Humane Care and Use of Laboratory Animals at the University of Minnesota. According to the information provided, OLAW understands that 46 mice were subjected to an unapproved anesthetic procedure.

The corrective actions consisted of having the Principal Investigator amend the protocol to include the procedure. The procedure will not be conducted until the amendment has been approved.

Based on its assessment of this explanation, OLAW understands that measures have been implemented to correct and prevent recurrence of this problem. OLAW concurs with the actions taken by the institution to comply with the PHS Policy. Please remember not to charge the NIH grant for any unauthorized animal activities.

Dear Dr. Wolff,

In keeping with the terms of our assurance, please be informed that we are making a report of noncompliance of an IACUC approved, NIH funded study involving mice. The basis of this report results from a post approval monitoring inspection. The report outlined that forty-six mice underwent an anesthetic procedure that was not approved in the protocol. This deviation in protocol occurred between the dates of March 6, 2019 and August 20, 2019.

We want to inform you that we consider this matter closed. A response was received from the PI indicating that an amendment has been submitted to the IACUC adding the anesthetic procedure for injection of cells and until such time that this amendment is approved, the procedure will not be conducted.
