The Office of Laboratory Animal Welfare (OLAW) acknowledges receipt of your May 31, 2019 letter reporting an instance of noncompliance with the PHS Policy on Humane Care and Use of Laboratory Animals at the University of Michigan, following up on an initial telephone report on May 31, 2019. According to the information provided, OLAW understands that eleven mice were euthanized by a method that differed from what was described in the approved protocol. The method used was acceptable under the American Veterinary Medical Association Guidelines for Euthanasia of Animals and was conducted correctly.

The corrective actions consisted of counseling the investigator responsible.

Based on its assessment of this explanation, OLAW understands that measures have been implemented to prevent recurrence of this problem. OLAW concurs with the actions taken by the institution to comply with the PHS Policy.

Dear Dr. Wolff:

The University of Michigan (U-M), in accordance with Assurance D16-00072 and the Public Health Service Policy on Humane Care and Use of Laboratory Animals (PHS Policy), provides this report of noncompliance occurring at the U-M. The IACUC discussed this matter on Monday, May 20, 2019.

Specifically, eleven mice, under grant number R01 HL123333, were euthanized using a method that was not approved on the specific IACUC approved protocol under which the animals were housed. The euthanasia method used is an AVMA approved method and euthanasia was conducted with proficiency.

The individual responsible for the protocol deviation is apologetic for the course of action. This individual recently transitioned from a fellow to a Research Assistant Professor and has had no prior instances of noncompliance at U-M. The U-M IACUC believes that this is an isolated event and that the chance of future occurrences is minimal.
