- Page 14, IACUC Responsibilities, #3 "If a quorum is not maintained, the proposal must Require Modification and only non-protocol related issues may be discussed. (The word tabled was replaced by the term Required Modifications.)
- Page 21, IACUC APPROVAL PROCESS, Designated Member Review, The approval letter will not be produced until both assigned reviewers, have indicated their approval. (The word "the" was removed after until; a comma was inserted after reviewers.)
- Page 21, IACUC APPROVAL PROCESS, Requirements for Approval, 4th sentence, "Research that
 has been approved by the IACUC is subject to review and approval, disapproved or Withhold
 Approval by the Research & Development committee and/or IO, but those officials may not
 approve research that has been disapproved by the IACUC. (The phrase "tabling" was replaced
 by Withhold Approval).
- Page 23-24, IACUC APPROVAL PROCESS, Requirements for Approval, 2rd sentence, At any time
 a request for approval (initial, annual continued review, triennial review, amendments,
 etc.) comes before the IACUC, the PI and all team members on the protocol being
 reviewed must have all mandatory web-based animal training up to date and be
 compliant with Occupational Health screening before final approval is granted. (The
 word "processes" was replaced with screening).
- Page 24, IACUC REVIEW PROCESS, Continuing Protocol Review, 4th paragraph, It is the PI's
 responsibility to verify completion of credentialing (including Occupational Health screening)
 before team members begin work in the lab. (the phrase "including Occupational Health
 screening" was added).
- Page 27, Offsite Animals, 2nd paragraph, A Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is in effect for personnel who plan to house or use animals at any OVAMC facility where such animals are purchased with UNMC or Creighton University funds as part of UNMC-sponsored or Creighton University-sponsored research and to personnel who house or use animals at UNMC or Creighton University where such animals are purchased with VA or VA Nonprofit-sponsored research. (The words "at any OVAMC facility where such animals are purchased with UNMC or Creighton University funds as part of UNMC-sponsored or Creighton University-sponsored research and to personnel who house or use animals" was removed).
- Page 33, Determination for ACORP Completion, A, "The IACUC <u>will not</u> require an ACORP
 The IACUC will not require an ACORP submission if:". (The word submission was added).

- 1. Page 25, Post Approval Monitoring (PAM), Membership, "A Post-Approval Monitoring Team will be established as a subgroup of the IACUC members. This paragraph will be edited as follows:
- A Post-Approval Monitoring Team will be established as a subgroup of the IACUC members. It
 will consist of a minimum of 3 members and when necessary, Principal Investigators who have
 appropriate scientific expertise and knowledge of animal regulations and procedures."

This statement is intended to note that **at least** 3 members will complete PAM audits for All active protocols within a calendar year. This statement allows for MORE auditors when our protocol numbers are high and LESS when protocol numbers are low.

• Page 26, Animal Tissue Transfer, 2nd sentence, "The donor, recipient, and IACUC Chair or Vice-Chair must sign the form. The recipient is no longer required to sign on the revised form, so the word recipient will be removed. The sentence that reads "If the recipient investigator is from than outside institution, an official from that institution must provide a letter documenting approval to conduct research at that institution." The entire sentence will be removed as there is no longer a requirement for the letter of approval to conduct research". This change is also reflected in the 2015 version of the Animal Tissue Transfer form.
