Dear Dr. Polik,

The Office of Laboratory Animal Welfare (OLAW) acknowledges receipt of your March 14, 2018 letter reporting an instance of noncompliance with the PHS Policy on Humane Care and Use of Laboratory Animals at Hope College, following up on an initial telephone report on February 6, 2018. According to the information provided, OLAW understands that an individual was cleaning salt water fish tanks and interacting with the animals but had not completed formal training.

The corrective actions consisted of having the individual stop the animal activity until training was completed. The training was successfully completed and the individual resumed the activities with the fish.

Based on the information provided, OLAW is satisfied that appropriate actions have been taken to investigate, correct, and prevent recurrence of the noncompliance. Your prompt and thorough resolution of this matter is commendable and consistent with the PHS Policy philosophy of monitored self-regulation. We appreciate having been informed about this matter and find no cause for further action by this Office.

Dear Dr. Wolff:

Hope College, in accordance with Assurance A3971-01 and PHS Policy IV.F.3., provides this report of noncompliance regarding a situation where an individual was interacting with vertebrate animals (fish) without completing the training required by our Assurance. This occurred with animals approved by the IACUC, "Van Kley Museum Animal Presentations," approval number 011801.

On February 2, 2018, it came to the attention of the IACUC Chair, Susan M. Fraley, DVM, that a Hope College Business Services employee, had been cleaning our salt water tanks without having gone through the IACUC required training. While<sup>(b)</sup> (6) has extensive experience with maintaining salt water tanks and the animals therein, because he had not undergone the formal IACUC approved training, this was a situation of noncompliance. That day Dr. Fraley contacted the Primary Investigator (PI) of record for this protocol Lori Hertel as well the (b) (6) about this oversight. On February 6, Dr. Fraley had a phone conversation with you about the situation during which you suggested that this was a reportable noncompliance issue because (b) (6) was having contact with the inside of the salt water tanks. Also on February 6 Dr. Fraley informed the Institutional Officer (IO) Dr. William Polik of the noncompliance and the plan to correct it.

The following corrective action plan was implemented after the incident:

- On February 2, The Chair of the IACUC Dr. Fraley informed the (b) (6)
   (b) (6) and the PI for this protocol Lori Hertel that (b) (6) would need to
- undergo the required training, and could not interact with any campus animals until that training had been completed.
- 2. Ms. Hertel and (b) (6) emailed the Chair Dr. Fraley that day and February 5 (respectively) that they recognized this oversight was a noncompliance matter and would correct it immediately.
- 3. On February 6, Dr. Fraley called the OLAW Division of Compliance to report the matter.
- 4. On February 6, Dr. Fraley informed the IO Dr. Polik about the matter.
- 5. On February 6, Dr. Fraley informed (b) (6) that he would need to go through the requisite training prior to working with animals again.
- 6. (b) (6) responded that day with his willingness to comply.
- 7. On February 13, (b) (6) completed the training required by the IACUC.


