The Office of Laboratory Animal Welfare (OLAW) acknowledges receipt of your June 12, 2017 letter reporting an incident of noncompliance with the PHS Policy on Humane Care and Use of Laboratory Animals at Michigan State University. Your letter supplements the information in a telephone prompt report to this office on May 12, 2017. According to the information provided, OLAW understands that three mice were found alive in a carcass freezer subsequent to attempted CO2 euthanasia. It is understood that the animal activities were funded by the PHS.

Corrective and preventive actions included the IACUC Chair discussing the incident with the PI and the responsible grad student. The grad student's animal privileges were temporarily rescinded. It was determined that the grad student would develop a euthanasia procedure checklist, receive hands-on training, and would be monitored during euthanasia until deemed proficient. Training has been completed and the grad student has regained animal privileges.

OLAW believes that the corrective and preventative measures put in place by Michigan State University are consistent with the provisions of the PHS Policy on Humane Care and Use of Laboratory Animals. We appreciate being informed of this issue and find no cause for further action by this office.

Michigan State University, in accordance with Assurance A3955-01 and PHS Policy IV.F.3., provides this report of noncompliance. This letter is follow up to a verbal report to Dr. Bret Morse on 5/12/17 regarding a protocol in which euthanasia was improperly performed. The IACUC Chair discussed the incident with PI and grad student the afternoon of the incident. The grad student was informed that animal privileges were temporarily rescinded. "

There was a meeting with Chair, PI, grad student, IACUC Administrator, Research Liaison, Clinical Veterinarian, and Training Coordinator to discuss incident. It was determined that the grad student would devise a euthanasia procedure checklist which would be reviewed by Chair and vet staff, receive additional hands-on training, and will be monitored during euthanasia until deemed proficient. Training has been completed and the grad student has regained animal privileges.



The IACUC discussed the incident at their June meeting and were satisfied with the actions
