The components of the occupational health and safety program for medical evaluation and preventative medicine for those working with vertebrate animals are in place however, the IACUC requested better monitoring and adherence to the program due to an increased number of gaps in documentation. Additionally, the IACUC recommended moving from a paper-based system to an electronic monitoring system to accommodate more efficient and effective compliance as well as future growth in the use of animals. A letter has been sent to EH&S Senior Director outlining the IACUC's concerns.
