Dear Dr. Russell,

The Office of Laboratory Animal Welfare (OLAW) acknowledges receipt of your December 30, 2019 letter reporting noncompliance with the Public Health Service (PHS) Policy on Humane Care and Use of Laboratory Animals (Policy) at the University of Texas Southwestern Medical Center. This letter was preceded by a preliminary report that was provided by voicemail on September 23, 2019 to OLAW. According to the information supplied, OLAW understands on September 11, 2019, seven cages of mice were brought by laboratory staff to a lab room that was not approved for animal use on the IACUC protocol. The animals were in the unapproved location for approximately eight hours but did not undergo any procedures. The letter indicated that the associated animal work was funded by a National Institutes of Health grant.

Corrective actions included the Principal Investigator (PI) submitting an amendment to the protocol which was later approved by the IACUC, and the IACUC Chair and Manager met with the PI to discuss the incident.

OLAW accepts the corrective actions and concurs with the submission of this report to comply with the PHS Policy. We appreciate being informed of this incident and find no cause for further action by this Office.

Dear Dr. Morse,

I write to provide a final report of non-compliance with the *PHS Policy on Humane Care and Use of Laboratory Animals* regarding an incident on September 11, 2019. The IACUC determined that research staff brought seven cages of mice to a laboratory room that was not approved for animal use. The animals were present in the unapproved location for approximately eight hours and did not undergo any experimental procedures when there. This determination was based on observations made by an IACUC Manager and Senior IACUC Liaison who were visiting the room to review it for potential animal use. The incident was first reported to you via voicemail message by an IACUC Manager on September 23, 2019. The PI agreed to not use the location again until it was approved by the IACUC.

The PI submitted an amendment to add a new animal use location to their protocol on October 4, 2019. The IACUC Chair and Manager met with the PI to discuss the incident on October 15, 2019. The amendment was approved thereafter on October 21, 2019.

We believe the actions taken by the IACUC are appropriate for this situation.
