Dear Dr. Giuffrida,

The Office of Laboratory Animal Welfare (OLAW) acknowledges receipt of your June 8, 2019 letter reporting an adverse event involving research rats at the University of Texas Health Science Center. According to the information provided, OLAW understands that six rats with head caps were subjected to approved foot shock procedures. Upon receiving the shock, the animals jumped and hit their head caps against the side of the containment box which damaged the caps. One head cap became dislodged.

The corrective actions consisted of euthanizing the rat with the missing head cap, allowing the remaining rats to serve as controls, and amending the protocol to replace foot shock with restrained tail shock.

Based on its assessment of this explanation, OLAW understands that measures have been implemented to correct and prevent recurrence of this problem. OLAW concurs with the actions taken by the institution to comply with the PHS Policy on Humane Care and Use of Laboratory Animals.

Dear Principal Investigator,						
A Prompt Report for the above listed protocol was reviewed by the Institutional Animal Care and Use Committee (IACUC) during the May 29, 2019 meeting.						
<u>Summary of the event</u> : The PI reported that six rats with head cap cannulae implants, underwent IACUC approved inescapable foot shock paradigm procedures. The shuttle boxes used in the procedure allowed the rats sufficient space to jump in reaction to the applied shock, hitting their heads against the box and resulting in damage to the implants. All rats displayed observable damage to the head cap but only five were allowed to continue the study as control as animals. The head cap of the sixth rat was no longer attached to the rat and therefore the animal was removed from the study and humanely euthanized.						
<u>Summary of actions taken by PI, IACUC or institutional officials prior to Committee meeting</u> : The PI temporarily stopped foot shock procedures, consulted with other investigators on appropriate alternatives and submitted an amendment to replace foot shock procedures with restrained tail shock procedures. The amendment was approved by the IACUC on May 8, 2019.						
<u>Determination/IACUC Directed Actions:</u> The Committee determined that the incident was an unexpected adverse event. The Committee determined that the research continues to satisfy the requirements for IACUC approval. The actions taken by the investigator to protect animal welfare were appropriate. The corrective action plan was acceptable as written.
