Dear Dr. Calzonetti,

The Office of Laboratory Animal Welfare (OLAW) acknowledges receipt of your September 3, 2019 letter reporting an adverse event involving rats in shipment from the University of Toledo, following up on an initial telephone report on July 19, 2019. According to the information provided, OLAW understands that eleven rats died during shipment from Toledo to New York. The animals had been properly prepared for shipment, had adequate food and water, and ambient temperature was within acceptable limits. This is the second such incident with this shipper.

The preventive action consisted of stopping use of this shipper for any future animal transport.

Based on its assessment of this explanation, OLAW understands that measures have been taken to prevent recurrence of this problem. OLAW concurs with the actions taken by the institution to comply with the PHS Policy on Humane Care and Use of Laboratory Animals.

Dear Dr. Wolff:

In accordance with Assurance A3414-01 and PHS Policy IV.F.3., The University of Toledo (UToledo), provides this report of noncompliance regarding an incident involving a shipment of rats to Albany, New York. The University of Toledo IACUC was made aware of the incident on August 21, 2019. NIH funds were used to purchase the rats.

On July 17, 2019, 24 rats were shipped from UToledo to Taconic Biosciences in Albany, New York, using World Courier, an international animal transport company. The rats were shipped as an overnight delivery and ambient temperatures were predicted to be in the range of mid to upper 70's. All rats were carefully packaged by training staff for shipping, and given food and hydration to last at least three days in case of delay. Actual temperatures during the trip were low to mid 70's. Upon arrival at the final destination in Albany, New York on July 18, 2019, it was discovered that 11 rats were dead. For future shipments, The University of Toledo has ceased use of this courier for any and all shipment of live animals.


