The Office of Laboratory Animal Welfare (OLAW) acknowledges receipt of your June 20, 2019 letter reporting an adverse event involving rats from the University of Toledo, following up on an initial telephone report on May 28, 2019. According to the information provided, OLAW understands out of a total of 88 rats, four animals had died and two required euthanasia after being shipped from Toledo to Finland. The shipping company stated that the animals had food and water and that all procedures were conducted appropriately. The recipient institution has filed a complaint against the shipper.

The University of Toledo (UToledo), in accordance with Assurance A3414-01 and PHS Policy IV.F.3., provides this report of noncompliance regarding an incident regarding international shipment of rats to Finland, reported to the IACUC on June 19, 2019.

On May 14, 2019, 88 rats were shipped from UToledo to the University of Finland, using an international animal transport company (b) (4) The trip required stops in (b) (6) before delivery of the animals to their final destination. All rats were given adequate food and hydration for the trip by UToledo. Upon arrival at the final destination in Finland on May 17, 2019, it was discovered that four (4) rats were dead and two (2) more required euthanasia. The international transport company used has conducted an independent investigation into the incident and found all proper procedures were followed. Despite this, the University of Finland has filed a complaint against the company.

No NIH funds were used on this incident.


