The Office of Laboratory Animal Welfare (OLAW) acknowledges receipt of your June 14, 2018 letter reporting a serious deviation from the provisions of the *Guide for the Care and Use of Laboratory Animals* at the University of Toledo. According to the information provided, OLAW understands that five mice died of asphyxiation as a result of the cage not being properly docked into the air flow system on the biocontainment rack.

The corrective action consisted of retraining the Principal Investigator and staff on the proper use of the rack. A new caging system was ordered to replace the current one. This new system will not have air-tight cages which should prevent a recurrence of such an incident.

Based on its assessment of this explanation, OLAW understands that measures have been implemented to correct and prevent recurrence of this problem. OLAW concurs with the actions taken by the institution to comply with the PHS Policy on Humane Care and Use of Laboratory Animals.

Dear Dr. Wolff:

The University of Toledo, in accordance with Assurance A3414-01 and PHS Policy IV.F.3., provides this report of noncompliance regarding an incident of animals being found dead, reported to the IACUC on May 9, 2018.

On May 21, 2018, a cage of five mice was found dead in the Biocontainment Unit (BCU) after being transferred to it by the investigator's staff. The cage was not properly positioned and latched on the cage rack in order to engage the air flow system, therefore the mice died of asphyxiation. The investigator's staff and Principal Investigator were retrained on proper use of the BCU cages on May 22, 2018. Additionally, the Department of Laboratory Animal Resources (DLAR) has ordered new caging to replace the BCU caging system. The new caging will replace the air-tight cages/racks from our operation completely. This will prevent future occurrences of death resulting from improper cage placement.

At their meeting on June 13, 2018, the IACUC also reviewed and accepted the corrective action plan as submitted by DLAR. This protocol is not NIH-funded.
