Results: A focused inspection was completed on 04AUG2020. All regulated animals were inspected. The IACUC meeting minutes for 2020 (since last routine inspection) were reviewed. A discussion was held with the Office of Animal Welfare Assurance Director and a post approval monitor. All regulated animals appeared healthy during the inspection. All were in good body condition. None were dehydrated. All animals had access to water and food as required by the Animal Welfare Act. IACUC records reviewed and discussions with OAWA staff did not identify any regulated animals that were crushed in a trash compactor or died due to improper anesthetic use.
