Program for Animal Care and Use Updates for 2019:

Update to Back-up Veterinarian:

(b) (6) was appointed as an IACUC Member. In addition, one of our non-affiliated members and our student member departed the committee. We still have a non-affiliated member serving on the committee and a new student member appointment is in progress.

Occupational Health & Safety Updates:

(b) (6) The Office of RIsk & Safety shares an office suite with the Office of Sponsored Programs which has strengthened the safety partnership and communication between the two departments.

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Animal Care Facility/Maintenance Updates:

- PIs are seeking funding for a renovation project for the animal facilities, including the purchase
 of a new cage washer, water bottle filler, and drains.
- Several parts replaced on HACF cage washer.
- Ductwork sealed in hibernaculum to prevent leaks.
- · Glove dispensers, new hose reels, and tool grips installed in HACF.
- Additional router installed in HACF for better Wi-Fi.
- Landline installed in HACF to improve communication with facilities management staff and to allow easy access to call in the case of an emergency or veterinary concern.
- Live animal traps replaced sticky vermin traps in animal housing rooms.

- Standard Operating Procedure for use and maintenance of the Somnosuite Anesthesia Machine was updated.
- Animal bedding dump station recertified June 2019.
- · HACF installed a decontamination mat at the entrance of the facility.
- · Additional cold room added in Halsey as satellite housing
