# **2019 Programmatic Changes**

#### 1. Committee Members:

- **a.** Scientific member, (b) (6) left the Committee in June 2019 for employment outside of the University.
- **b.** The Institutional Official has appointed member to the Committee. (b) (6) as a new scientist
- c. The position of Vice-Chair of the ACUC, previously held by been terminated since this is not a regulatory requirement. In instances when the Chair is unavailable, the Chair will designate another member of the Committee to serve as an "Acting Chair" for the limited time during his/her absence only.
- 2. Annual Protocol Review Changes: In an effort to reduce regulatory burden for PIs, Contact Persons and the Committee, the ACUC voted unanimously to not require the submission and review of certain first and second annual protocols beginning October 2019. Protocols that are funded by PHS, DoD, UVA departments or industry and describe the use of rats of the genus Rattus, mice of genus Mus, birds, frogs or fish species do not require first and second annual full Committee review. These protocols will be reviewed at their Third Annual anniversary. In order to follow the annual protocol cycle and ensure that animal handler training and occupational health assessment requirements are met, the ACUC Office will process the continued renewal for these protocols during the month of their first and second annual anniversary.

First and second annual protocols that describe the use of USDA regulated species or are funded by the Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) will continue to be reviewed by the Committee annually at a convened meeting. Modified annual protocols of this category are reviewed by the full committee review method (FCR), while annual protocols without modifications are reviewed by the designated member review method (DMR).
