Review of Minutes

January Meeting Minutes approved as written.

Business Items

Proposed revisions to Directions for CO2 Euthanasia of Rodents
 IACUC reviewed the changes to the guidance document based on the newly updated AVMA
 Euthanasia Guidelines (2020) and voted to approve. IACUC website will be updated with new
 version.

- 2. Proposed revisions to Animal Transportation Policy IACUC reviewed the changes to the policy and agreed to discuss during spring seminannual program review to finalize the details. The main item for revision is USDA-regulated animals being transported with LAR input/personal rather than restricting it to LAR vehicles.
- 3. Update on animal welfare concern with livestock (ag teaching)

 The Chair updated the committee on progress made on this concern, final report should be made available at the next IACUC meeting for the committee to discuss.
- 4. Protocol review process for RIC Tenants As more RIC Tenants are needing IACUC protocol review and approval, protocol review process for RIC tenants was outlined, and is identical to all other IACUC protocols submitted for review. RIC tenants will pay a fee for any IACUC services they require and how those funds will be spent is up to the committee, typically near end of fiscal year/start of new fiscal year.

Attending Veterinarian (AV) Report

- USDA inspection report
 - USDA unannounced inspection occurred January 28-30, 2020. There was one critical citation on the inspection report related to an item that had been self-identified and reported to the IACUC prior to the inspection. USDA also reminded the IACUC that the meeting minutes should include record of attendance and deliberation of meeting items. There will be a new inspector at the next inspection.
- Goat at ETRC ag teaching)
 A goat (companion animal for one of the client-owned horses) had been euthanized after an accident occurred. A veterinarian euthanized the animal promptly and the IACUC agreed that all actions taken were appropriate.
- 3. Diabetic mice death ; not PHS-funded)
 Diabetic mice in 1-2 cages were found dead due to water bottles not being changed out. LAR staff implemented corrective action of labeling cages with diabetic tag so LAR staff will know to monitor water consumption more closely (e.g. water bottle may need to be changed out more frequently.) IACUC agreed that appropriate actions were taken, no further actions required, and consider the matter closed.
- 4. Final Report on anonymous animal welfare concern (PHS-funded) The final report on an anonymous animal welfare concern was reviewed by the committee. The IACUC agreed to send a warning letter to the PI related to the protocol noncompliance items, as well as the need for the institution to report these noncompliances to OLAW, as outlined in NOT-OD-05-034. AAALAC will also be notified at the same time, as outlined in AAALAC FAQ H2. The PI has already been in contact with the program officer of the funding agency. Because there were additional concerns related that the IBC reviewed and discussed with the PI, a joint letter between the two committees will be issued. The IACUC that this matter could now be closed out.

PAM Report

The IACUC was informed of the past month's post-approval monitoring (PAM) reviews. Protocol information was reviewed during PAM reviews and minor adjustments were discussed based on current activity. Where appropriate, amendments will be submitted by PIs in a timely fashion to ensure approval is secured prior to start of the new/amended activities.

Report on animal welfare concern with livestock (ag teaching) The committee discussed this report at length and agreed that the animals were cared for appropriately, there were no animal welfare concerns, the claims could not be substantiated, and noted that the minor protocol noncompliances had been corrected with an amendment (personnel updates and facility addition). The IACUC agreed that there were significant communication issues underlying this concern, and those issues were outside the committee's purview. The IACUC agreed to send a letter to the PI and department head, providing suggestions to improve documentation of the daily and veterinary care of the animals. The IACUC considered this matter closed.

- 2. FYI: Pandemic plan for IACUC business processes
 RICRO IACUC Staff is working on a pandemic plan for CSU IACUC business processes, to clarify
 what would happen during a pandemic.
- 3. Kuali Protocols (KP) and Animal Management System (AMS) update: go-live date is May 21, 2020. May FCR protocols will be entered into KP so researchers will be given access prior to the go-live date for this to occur. KP will also be opened up to people needing to submit May continuing reviews and 4th year renewals. RICRO IACUC KP and AMS help website will be created to include FAQs and help documents.
