I am writing to let you know that we had a death in the chimpanzee colony today. Staun passed away this morning. He was a new QOL case with severe cardiac arrhythmias. He was reintroduced to his social group today and all was going well until he collapsed during an affiliative interaction. We attempted resuscitation for 40 min but we were unable to get him back.
