Humane Endpoints for Patricia 1399

Patricia (1278) is a 32 year old HCV negative, HBV negative, HIV negative female chimpanzee who has been diagnosed with multiple chronic disease processes by the veterinary staff at APF. The disease processes that Patricia is afflicted with includes chronic renal failure and systemic hypertension.

Clearly defined criteria and responsibilities have been agreed upon and the staff trained to observe for decompensation clinical signs. This does not preclude providing supportive therapy as needed, so long as the outcome will involve the possible return of Patricia to an acceptable quality of life in a reasonable amount of time. Humane euthanasia will be performed as required by the veterinarian in attendance.

1. Body weight should be monitored and used as an indicator of a potential debilitating condition. It is recommended that a loss of 25% of body weight within 3 months, a body condition score of 1 or a decrease below 45kg could be an endpoint. Patricia has unresponsive anorexia for 4 days with significant weight loss then euthanasia should be considered.
2. Patricia has been diagnosed with systemic hypertension which could possibly make her prone to a cerebrovascular insult. While Patricia's conditions are being medically managed, none of these treatments are curative. Possible early signs of stroke are loss of coordination, weakness in arms legs, and/or face (especially unilateral) and seizures should be considered a potential endpoint.
3. Patricia has chronic renal failure. Her serial blood chemistry analyses show a progressive increase in blood urea nitrogen and creatinine. Possible end stage clinical signs such as persistent vomiting, blindness or disorientation due to increased azotemia should be considered an endpoint. Progressive, severe anemia is a clinical adjunct to chronic end stage renal failure.

It is the consensus of the Alamogordo Primate Facility veterinary staff that due to the grave prognosis associated with these disease processes, Patricia (1399) should be humanely euthanized if one or several established endpoints are reached.
