(b) Ventilation.

*** On March 19, 2014 Liberty Research Inc. transported 43 adult dogs from their facility to a facility in Kalamazoo, MI.

The transport kennels were packed into a trailer is such a way as to impede adequate ventilation and to obstruct normal air flow. This situation resulted in the death of one dog and the necessity of having to euthanize a second dog at the receiving facility.

The facility needs to review its shipping procedures to ensure the safe transport of animals.

Correct before the next use of trailer.

3.14(c)(1) DIRECT

PRIMARY ENCLOSURES USED TO TRANSPORT LIVE DOGS AND CATS.

(c) Ventilation.

*** While inspecting the primary enclosures within the trailer following its return to the shipping facility from the receiving facility, it was noted that the back walls of the transport kennels were covered with clear plastic, thus preventing adequate circulation of air. In adddition all of the kennels had filtration curtains which may have contributed to decreased ventilation.

The facility must review its transport procedures to ensure the safety and well-being of all animals during transport. Correct before animals are again transported in the trailer.

(f) Primary enclosures

***The 43 large transport kennels were positioned in such a way within the trailer (four across) as to make removal in the event of an emergency difficult and time consuming.

The facility must review its transport procedures to ensure the safety and well-being of all animals during transport. Correct before animals are again transported in the trailer.
