Dear Ms. Caudill,

The Office of Laboratory Animal Welfare (OLAW) acknowledges receipt of your December 20, 2019 letter reporting a serious deviation from the provisions of the *Guide for the Care and Use of Laboratory Animals* at Yale University, following up on an initial telephone report on November 20, 2019. According to the information provided, OLAW understands that one mouse pup had been cannibalized by the dam after the cage was without food for one day. Some cages in the room receive experimental diet and are not fed regular chow and this could have contributed to the problem.

The corrective actions consisted of retraining the animal care staff responsible and counseling the laboratory staff to ensure that all cages have food after handling.

Based on its assessment of this explanation, OLAW understands that measures have been implemented to correct and prevent recurrence of this problem. OLAW concurs with the actions taken by the institution to comply with the PHS Policy on Humane Care and Use of Laboratory Animals.

Dear Dr. Morse:

In accordance with the Public Health Service Policy and Yale University's Animal Welfare Assurance (#D16-00146), I write to report the result of the fact-finding activities regarding an incident that the Yale Animal Resource Center (YARC) identified on September 6, 2019.

On September 6, 2019, YARC found a cage without food, housing a dam and litter of 7 pups born on August 25, 2019. It was determined that the cage had been without food for 24 hours. One pup had been cannibalized, all other animals were in good body condition so it is unclear if a day without food would have precipitated cannibalism or if this is an expected occasional observation in large mouse breeding colonies. Further fact finding revealed that the cages were changed 2 days prior to the incident, thus that associated stress could also have contributed to the incident. Since this room is supplied with 3 types of cages which are labelled with the type of chow or no chow (for experimental diet) for investigator use, it is possible that a cage without food was inadvertently selected for use.

The staff member responsible for servicing the room the day prior to this finding received retraining. The post-approval monitoring Specialist reinforced requirements with lab staff to ensure all cages handled by researchers have food when returned to the rack. The IACUC reviewed the details of the incident and accepted this remediation plan, without modification, at its regularly scheduled meeting on October 9, 2019.
