The Office of Laboratory Animal Welfare (OLAW) acknowledges receipt of your March 31, 2020 letter reporting an incident of noncompliance with the PHS Policy on the Humane Care and Use of Laboratory Animals at Yale University. According to the information provided, OLAW understands that on December 26, 2019 a mouse rack was found disconnected from water. Ten adult mice and seven litters were found deceased. The remaining mice were provided supportive care and the rack was reconnected. The animals were supported with NIH funds.

Corrective and preventive actions included the husbandry technician responsible for this room receiving retraining on standard operating procedures. It is understood that Yale University will be notifying the funding component of the incident.

OLAW believes that the corrective and preventive measures put in place by Yale University are consistent with the provisions of the PHS Policy on Humane Care and Use of Laboratory Animals. We appreciate being informed of this matter and find no cause for further action by this office at this time.

Dear Dr. Morse:

In accordance with the Public Health Service Policy and Yale University's Animal Welfare Assurance (#D16-00146), I write to report the results of the fact-finding activities regarding an incident that the Yale Animal Resource Center (YARC) identified.

On December 26, 2019, YARC found a rack disconnected from the water source. Ten adult mice and 7 litters were deceased. The rack was reconnected to the water source, supplemental bottles were provided to cages of subset of affected remaining animals and Veterinary Clinical Services assessed the condition of the remaining animals in the YARC Managers conducted fact finding and the husbandry technician responsible for servicing the room received re-training of standard operating procedures. The IACUC reviewed the details of the incident and accepted the remediation plan at its regularly scheduled meeting on March 11, 2020.

This incident will also be reported to the appropriate NIH Institute/Center in accordance with University procedure. Please contact Dr. Troy Hallman (troy.hallman@yale.edu) directly if you require additional information.
