Dear Dr. O'Byrne,

The Office of Laboratory Animal Welfare (OLAW) acknowledges receipt of your August 21, 2018 letter reporting an instance of noncompliance with the PHS Policy on Humane Care and Use of Laboratory Animals at Wake Forest University. According to the information provided, OLAW understands that three nonhuman primates underwent a cystocentesis procedure which was not listed on the approved protocol. No adverse effects were noted in the monkeys.

The corrective actions consisted of counseling the Principal Investigator (PI), issuing a Notification of Correction Letter to the PI, and having the PI ensure that staff reviews the content of the protocols before conducting animal activities.

Based on its assessment of this explanation, OLAW understands that measures have been implemented to prevent recurrence of this problem. OLAW concurs with the actions taken by the institution to comply with the PHS Policy.

The Wake Forest University Animal Care & Use Program experienced a deviation from standard procedure that was determined by the Wake Forest University (WFU) Institutional Animal Care and Use Committee (IACUC) to be reportable to the NIH Office of Laboratory Animal Welfare.

<u>PHS funding</u>: P40 OD010965. If appropriate, we will forward to our sponsored research office and all direct costs associated with the procurement, care and use of the animal(s) involved in this noncompliance event will be removed from this account and invoiced to and paid from a nonfederal source.

<u>Incident</u>: Three monkeys underwent a cyctocentisis procedure that was not on the approved protocol. The procedure is on other protocols of the same investigator. The procedure was performed correctly and without incident. There were no animal welfare concerns.

Preliminary Report: No preliminary report was made to OLAW.

<u>Resolution</u>: The WFU !ACUC contacted the Principal Investigator and discussed current Institutional policies and regulatory compliance related to this concern. The IACUC approved the following actions to resolve this incident:

- 1. A Notification of Correction Letter was sent to the Principal Investigator.
- 2. The Principal Investigator implemented a corrective action plan to review protocols and verify procedures to ensure this would not happen again.

All actions have been completed/implemented at this time and the WFU IACUC considers this non-compliance matter closed. The program oversight staff will continue to monitor animal care and use procedures to assure compliance with IACUC approved processes.
