VOTE on AUP actions: All 4 protocols have been approved (all 9 members voted). Major amendments 7 approved one DMR (all 9 members voted) Minor Amendments - All approved.

Incident Reports -

1. Care staff found blood on a cage and on food and reported to Vet staff. Both cages were changed. All mice active, alert, and hydrated per Vet Tech. The research staff had performed tail clips on older mice for genotyping. They are approved for clips on pups, but not older mice. IACUC Chair emailed PI requesting an amendment on tail snip procedure (submitted). The vet tech retrained staff. No further action needed

- 2. During a PAM visit, a lab member was describing her procedure for performing abdominal surgery. She acknowledged that she had not provided analgesics to animals during her last set of surgeries in April because the mice did not eat the carprofen tablets. The carprofen tablets in the lab had expired in February. It was recommended that the PI and research staff approved to do surgeries be retrained and that the analgesia be changed. Amendment submitted and approved. No further action needed.
- 3. Follow-up: Summerville Facility—AV reported that LAS has installed their own monitoring system. Still waiting on facilities to install temperature control. PIs will be allowed to house animals in the facility once the monitoring system is in place. Will follow up next month.
- 4. Follow-up: Veterinary staff reported high mortality (10 out of 24) in rats that had undergone surgery. DLAS had been in contact with lab personnel to develop a plan to prevent future mortalities. The IACUC voted to require the PI perform a limited number of surgeries on Friday (6) and wait till Tuesday to do the others to ensure the issue with survival had been resolved. When the PI was contacted immediately after the IACUC meeting they had already performed more surgeries without informing vets, but had followed plan to improve survival by preventing PICA. All rats survived surgeries. No further action is needed.

3. Old Business

- a) Update on Gazebo repair (Follow-up) Still waiting on quote. It was discovered that repairs more extensive than originally identified and HR requires 3 bids for any repair that exceeds \$3,000. DLAS has arranged for a second company to quote and will work with facilities to see if they can repair. Will update committee at the next convened meeting.
- 4. New Business Core usage page in ESIRIUS (Tim Wilson). All 9 members voted to delete this page in ESIRIUS

VOTE on AUP actions:

All 10 members voted to approve 11 protocols; table 1 protocol for FCR next month and 1 approve via DMR; Major amendments – All 10 members voted to approve 5 amendments and DMR 3 amendments (Note: Member 1 left the meeting while protocol 2014-0704 was discussed and Member 6 left the meeting while amendment 2009-0214 was discussed)

Incident Reports -

- 1. Follow-up: Summerville Facility—AV reported that LAS will move forward with their own monitoring system in addition to the one facilities uses. PIs will be allowed to house animals in the facility once the monitoring system is in place. Final monitoring system check should be tested this week (9/25/20). If all goes well animals can be moved back into will follow-up on next month's Agenda.
- 2. New During endotracheal intubation in surgery prep, the animal experienced complications including dusky (pale/purple) mucous membranes, dyspnea and ptyalism. The animal was moved to the OR and re-intubated following suction of the airway. The animal had low oxygen saturation and continued to show signs of dyspnea. An emergency cricotomy was attempted but during the procedure the animal became agonal and was euthanized with IV barbiturate overdose (Euthasol). The lab continued with Laparascopic surgical training posteuthanasia and a necropsy was performed afterwards. USDA was notified and they responded with "No further action needed". Vet 1 still waiting on additional information from necropsy and will report at the next convened meeting and AV will contact USDA with findings as well. Future surgeries will involve larger animals in case the age/size of the animal contributed to the complications.
- 3. New Two cages of weanling mice were found without food on 9/15/20. Cages were created on 9/11/20 after DLAS staff had serviced the room. Three of 8 weaned pups died. The lab member will be retrained. Retraining and disciplinary action has been taken for DLAS staff that missed these cages. No further action needed

VOTE on AUP actions: All 7 Members present for the protocol/amendments and Annual review voted to DMR 1 protocol and approve all other protocols and major amendments

Incident Reports -

- 1. Follow-up: Incident #56 Summerville Facility The alarm system for HVAC malfunction was tested and approved. PIs at Summerville have resumed their experiments in the facility effective October 5th. No further action is needed.
- 2. Follow-up: Incident #64 During endotracheal intubation in surgery prep, the animal experienced complications including dusky (pale/purple) mucous membranes, dyspnea and ptyalism. Final test confirms no clear reason why the animal died. USDA is satisfied with the report. No further action is needed.
- 3. New: Incident #66 A cage housing 3 mice, was found with significant amount of blood on the bedding and nestlet. PI collected tail sample for genotyping (morning 9/25). The PI had already been informed that tail clip of mice was not approved in her protocol and had been asked to submit an amendment. The PI was told not to perform any further tail clip until approval had been obtained. Research staff were trained in the tail clip procedures and the PI submitted an amendment. This incident was discussed at the same time as #68 as it was the same PI. IACUC has recommended a number of responses (see below)
- 4. New: Incident #67 PI performed surgery on rats that was not approved in his protocol. He was approved for the procedure in mice. The rats have been transferred to another PI who is approved for the procedures and the first PI has been named on the protocol so that the rats can be maintained. The PI has submitted an amendment for the surgical procedures. A letter was sent to OLAW as this is a reportable incident. The IACUC chair will send an email to the PI that will state amendment for the surgeries and DOCA implant was approved, but the IACUC requests that PI does not perform any of these surgeries until after OLAW is satisfied with our response to the incident. Surgery logs will be requested, training provided by IACUC Chair and AUP reviewed by all personnel named on the protocol before a final report is sent to OLAW. Expenses associated with these animals have already been transferred to a non-NIH account.

5. New: Incident #68 New – Two mice were found in a cage without food or bedding. Surgery had been performed late in the previous day. The technician had left work without allowing for full post-op making arrangements for monitoring the mice during recovery. There was a lengthy discussion as this was the third incident report for this PI in three months. The committee agreed that this will be reported to OLAW in addition the PI will be charged a fine paid from a non-NIH account, surgery will be halted until all lab members receive surgery training with an emphasis on monitoring and recovery, the IACUC Chair will be make an in-person presentation to the lab on animal welfare and regulatory requirements for animal research and review of the PIs AUP. It is possible any future incident will result in suspension of the PI's protocol.

3. Old Business

a) Update on Gazebo repair (Follow-up) – The company hired to make the necessary repairs failed to show up twice. LAS has negotiated making the repairs with another vendor and will report at the next convened meeting if all repairs are done.

4. New Business

- a) Inspection of surgical records (PI surgeries in the Vivarium) 7 records verified. Sent 2 PI's templates of the IACUC recommended form to consider using
- b) AAALAC Discussion All members have been sent the itinerary. AAALAC liked our program description. All research personnel have been sent a power point presentation and the IACUC staff has made the necessary arrangements for hotel, parking, lodging food etc. The committee thanked the IACUC staff for their help in making this all happen and a special thank you to our OHP Coordinator/IT expert who spent many many hours in preparing all the documents required.
- c) Policy on protocol and amendment review A very lengthy discussion on a revised policy on protocol and amendment review. The new policy includes the recent approved VVC review but abolishes minor amendments. The committee voted to approve the revised policy and will put this topic on the agenda early Spring to make sure the policy addresses all review contingencies.

VOTE on AUP actions: All 9 members voted to approve all 6 protocols, Major amendments all 9 members voted to approve 7 and DMR 4 of them. All VVC and minor amendments approved by all 9 members present

Incident Reports -

- 1. Follow up #67: Surgery on rats that was not approved in his protocol which was reported to OLAW. PI and lab staff received compliance training and reviewed their AUP, costs associated with animals have been paid with non-NIH funds and NIH notified of this, PIs protocol has been amended. PI has been informed that data from rats cannot be used as preliminary data for a grant or published in a manuscript that states that animal procedures were approved by the IACUC. All actions were completed by October 30th, OLAW was informed and they have closed the incident. The IACUC Chair notified the PI that they can proceed with the DOCA surgery. No further action is needed.
- 2. Follow up #68— No postop monitoring after surgery 2017-0868. This was the third incident in 3 months from this lab. Two previous incidents were associated with performing tail clip without IACUC approval. Repeated non-compliance was reported to OLAW. All lab members received compliance training and reviewed their AUP, surgery was stopped until all lab members were retrained in surgical procedures, lab was fined \$5000 by IACUC and the PI was informed that another incident report could result in suspension of AUP by IACUC. These actions were completed by Nov 2nd and OLAW informed on Nov 3rd. No further action needed.
- 3. New #71 Mouse room climate PI found three dead litters and assumed the room was too cold. LAS checked daily temperature log and temperature monitoring of air entering the room. The temperatures were within the recommended range on the days the litters died. The PI was informed that it was unlikely that the pups died from hypothermia. No further action needed.
- 4. New #72 Improper Euthanasia 5 live neonates and 6 dead adult mice were found in freezer without secondary method of euthanasia. LAS euthanized the mice and contacted PI. The PI and all research personnel have been retrained in appropriate methods of euthanasia. PI has requested a VVC amendment to add another means of euthanasia. No further action is needed.
- 3. New #73 Cage found without food. Two of the four mice in the cage were dead and had been cannibalized. LAS had failed to identify cages were without food. LAS staff disciplined. Procedures used to improve identification of cages without food will be discussed with the incoming LAS Director/AV that starts January 1, 2020. No further action is needed.

4. Old Business

- a) Update on Gazebo repair (Follow-up). All repairs have been completed as of 10/23/2020.
- b) SOPs for satellite housing: IACUC office received SOPs for 2 rodent satellites, existing SOPs for aquarium and zebra fish core, one rodent SOP still needed.

5. New Business

- a. AAALAC Discussion The site visitors identified 8 items for improvement, three are relevant to the IACUC. No mandatory findings. The IACUC sent a response to the 8 items to AAALAC last week and the report was shared at the meeting with all members. AAALAC will recommend full accreditation.
- Animals are being single housed for longer than necessary. The IACUC Chair emailed
 25 PIs approved for single housing of rodents for experimental reasons reminding

- them to minimize duration of single housing. AUP will now require a justification for duration of single housing in addition to reason for single housing.
- Some equipment in PI procedure room was not clean. Confirming clean appearance of behavioral and experimental equipment has been added to inspection form.
- Containers of ethanol, formaldehyde and unknown liquid were not double contained. Looking for double containment has been added to the inspection form.
- 6. PAM Reports No PAM visits this month
- 7. Congruency Report 2 conducted, one AUP needed a Major amendment
- 8. PI lab inspections 7 labs inspected. One lab needs to be trained on keeping surgical records, the IACUC Chair and Member 1 will meet with the PI and lab staff the week after Thanksgiving and then an announced follow up inspection will be done to assure the records are capturing information required by the IACUC.

VOTE on AUP actions: All 7 members present voted to approve 4 AUPS and to DMR 1. One member abstained on voting for major amendments. The vote was to approve 2 and DMR 2 to AV. VVC and minor amendments were approved.

Incident Reports -

- Mouse bit the gloved thumb of a research staff member. Individual followed protocol to cleanse
 the bite and the incident was followed up by Employee Health. Animal was euthanized for a
 scheduled experiment. No further action is needed.
- On 12/13, the DLAS supervisor was made aware of increased temperature in the room by care staff. This room is normally set at 82-85 degrees. The supervisor unplugged the heater in the room, although it was not actively heating at the time. On 12/14, 9 animals housed on the top shelf of a rack positioned under a heating vent were found dead. Gross necropsy findings support hyperthermia as the cause of death. Lengthy discussion of room temperatures. LAS has already responded so that mice will no longer be housed on top of the rack and they are looking into temperature monitoring strips for inside the cages. A need for better Heat/AC monitoring and control is being discussed by upper Administration and facilities and LAS are exploring better methods for heating monitoring room temperature in the interim. The incident was reported to OLAW and LAS has implemented retraining of Supervisors/Caretakers because neither the AV nor the PI was informed of temperature problem until the mice were found dead on 12/14/20. This item will remain on the agenda for next month.
