- The Chair noted that he was looking into how lab inspections should be handed in manner that was consistent with social distancing guidance.
- The Chair noted that there had been any potential incidents non-compliance or animal welfare concern in the last month.

**7. New Business:**

- The Chair noted that Group B had returned to campus but that Group C returning was not likely to happen any time soon. Virtual meetings will continue for the foreseeable future.
