- a. On March 10, three recently weaned mice were found dead in a flooded cage. The appeared to have been flooded for two or three days before it was found. Investigation is on going.

There was a request to add a statement specifically noting that changes in duration or frequency of Category E behavioral tests need to be brought to the full committee for review. The Committee accepted the new policy with the addition of this statement.

- d. The Committee approved the emergency plan for animal care staff reductions due to COVID-19.
- e. The Committee performed their program review by reviewing a document describing the changes that have been made to the program since the last AAALAC Program Description. The Attending Veterinarian (AV) also described some recent changes that were not captured in this document due to COVID-19: a positive test among the animal care staff created a 20-30% reduction in staff for precautionary isolation. This prevented the plan for splitting the staff into two separate teams from being implemented. The Chair asked whether there was a noticeable decrease in investigator use. The AV said there has been a varied response from the labs about reducing colony size.

	The Griffith laboratory studies the inner ear sensory cells and hair cells. They utilize guinea pigs, rats, and mice to accomplish this task. They primarily euthanize animals prior to tissue collection of the inner ear hair cells. Other work involves knocking out genes and studying hearing and vestibular function in mice. They do this by studying startle responses and auditory brainstem responses in primarily anesthetized mice. This is a renewal of an existing protocol and they have been highly successful in publishing in this area. Mice have early endpoints or removal from treatment groups for any potentially dangerous experimental conditions. Rodents in this protocol have traditionally had minimal negative side effects.

a. On March 10, three recently weaned mice were found dead in a flooded cage. The conditions of the cage indicated that the cage had been flooded for two or three days before it was found. This means it was missed by multiple individuals over several cage checks. The Chair will draft an incident report for the next ACUC meeting.

8. Old Business:

a. The ACUC's policy for significant changes was brought back to the ACUC. This version had a few minor corrections and added a statement that amendments approved through the VVC process would be included in the minutes (which is just a clarification of the existing procedures). The Committee accepted the new policy with the addition of this statement.

New Business:

- a. The Attending Veterinarian provided the Committee with a description of "tips-only" surgical technique. The use of this technique requires appropriate training and must be described in the ASP. The Committee accepted this as guidance for PIs.
- b. The final report from the OLAW visit was included in the meeting materials. The Chair noted that OLAW found several good aspects about our program. The Attending Vet discussed three things that OLAW thought needed improvement. 1) The VVC policy should list specific drugs or have references to approved drug formularies. The Committee has reviewed changes to the VVC policy in response to this comment. 2) Rodent pups should be counted at first cage change or manipulation, which ever comes first. The AV expects some PI pushback and has sent his concerns to OACU. 3) An off-site zebrafish satellite facility lacked separation laboratory activities and is not operated at the same standard as the large on-site zebrafish facility. The Committee has not found this facility to be out of compliance and intends to challenge this comment.
- c. The spring semi-annual report was included in the meeting materials for committee members to review. No one had any issues with the report, and all were asked to provide signatures electronically.

- a. The Committee discussed issues that PIs were encountering when trying to add new investigators to their protocols. The two major issues were 1) enrollment in the Animal Exposure Program and 2) taking the Aseptic Techniques training.
 - It was taking months to get an appointment with OMS and then for OMS to update the database. The OACU observer asked to be notified of delays with OMS, and he would look into the issue.
 - 2) The online quiz that is supposed to be taken as part of the aseptic training is not working properly. The ACUC coordinators are looking into problem, and in the meantime the certificates will be waived and investigators can take the quiz at a later time. Investigators are still expected to watch the video prior to the didactic portion of training and should notify the ACUC coordinators when they have watched the video.
- b. The Chair gave a brief summary of the July ARAC meeting. Scientific merit review for NHP studies was the main topic of discussion.


