## 4. Discussion Items

a. Discussion of findings from semi-annual facility inspection conducted at beginning of the meeting (utilizing the OLAW checklist): Several items were noted but deemed very minor and not to be included in the report to the IO. These consisted of a terminated protocol still outside an animal room door; isoflurane scavenger cannister was used today but no weight was recorded; animal care elevator has screws missing from floor plate making a possible tripping hazard; and no insect traps in the feed/bedding room. One item determined to be minor to include in the report to the IO was: during records review it was noted that all PI's were not filling out the census sheets correctly (reminder email to be sent out).

The OLAW check list was used and sections 5 IACUC Membership and Functions and 6 IACUC Training were discussed in detail. One item determined to be minor to include in the report to the IO was: two IACUC members whose appointment started in January have not completed the required on-line training (per IACUC Policy 22 should be completed within 60 days of appointment; email to be sent to their supervisors asking that time be provided for them to complete this requirement).
