The Office of Laboratory Animal Welfare (OLAW) acknowledges receipt of your September 24, 2020 letter reporting an instance of noncompliance with the PHS Policy on Humane Care and Use of Laboratory Animals at the University of Alabama at Birmingham. Your letter supplements the information in the preliminary phone report received in early June 2020. According to the information provided, OLAW understands a lab self-reported that three female ferrets (out of a total of ten in the cohort) died during a routine research cigarette smoke exposure. A pressurized fresh air line had worked loose over time and detached from the mixing bottle. Because of this, the system supplied more concentrated smoke to the ferrets than typical, affecting the three smallest ferrets in the cohort. The involved animal activity was funded by the PHS.

Corrective actions included the IACUC requiring the Pl to maintain a checklist for the equipment to ensure the equipment is in working order before each exposure and to perform weekly checks of the machine when cleaned by the laboratory staff to minimize any reoccurrence.

OLAW appreciates the prompt consideration of this matter by the University of Alabama at Birmingham, which was consistent with the philosophy of institutional self-regulation. Based on the information provided, OLAW is satisfied that appropriate actions have been taken to investigate and correct the deficiency, and to prevent recurrence. We appreciate being informed of this matter and find no cause for further action by this office.
