Dear Dr. Koker,

The Office of Laboratory Animal Welfare (OLAW) acknowledges receipt of your September 28, 2020 letter reporting an instance of noncompliance with the PHS Policy on Humane Care and Use of Laboratory Animals at the University of Wisconsin Oshkosh following up on an initial July 30, 2020 notification by email.

According to the information provided, this Office understands that the University of Wisconsin Oshkosh Animal Care and Use Committee (ACUC) determined that instances of noncompliance occurred with respect to: failure to perform a daily animal check. The final report states on July 22, 2020 an animal room housing thirteen-lined ground squirrels was missed for daily animal checks. The error was discovered by the Laboratory Animal Manager the following morning. The manager observed each animal's health and their food and water supply, and all animals appeared healthy per the report. The principal investigator (PI) was contacted who missed the room check. It was also determined that the back-up system for ensuring completion of animal care checks failed because of human error. The PI instructed an animal caretaker to come in and provide food and water and complete the animal checks for that day. It is stated that at the time of submission of this report, all animals remain healthy and well.

A subcommittee of the IACUC reviewed the incident on July 31, 2020 and suggested strengthening the standard operating procedure (SOP) for daily room checks. The SOP was updated to include the following:

- The person assigned checks must state the name of the lab and facility in which animal checks were completed when sending the text to the backup person.
- The backup person is responsible for contacting the assigned person by 4:00 PM if a text is not received to confirm that checks were completed.
- If the backup person assigned cannot reach the assigned person, the backup should report to the facility to complete room checks.

The IACUC discussed the incident and approved the updated SOP at the meeting on September 14, 2020. It is stated the individual that missed the check received a written notice about the importance of checking the animals daily and attended a refresher training with the Laboratory Animal Manager. It is noted that this research is supported by PHS funds.
