New Proposals

- 2020-001 Demography of Northern Spotted Owls in Oregon and Washington (Lesmeister; <u>LR: L. Gallagher</u>) –
 modified proposal was reviewed and several Committee questions/comments were not addressed. The PI was
 invited into the Committee meeting to discuss these remaining questions and agreed to complete final revisions
 to Appendix A. The Committee voted to finalize approval by DMR (Gallagher, Klein).
- 2020-003 Sciurus tree squirrels in burned versus unburned forest stands on the Sam Houston NF, TX (Schaefer;
 LR: R. Perry) the Committee discussed the use of bait for a trail camera study and whether it materially altered the behavior of the squirrels. The Committee determined that behavior was not affected and this proposal met the criteria of a field study. The waiver from IACUC oversight was approved.

IACUC Old and New Business

- 2019-002 Barnett Significant Amendment the PI provided a minor correction noting animal numbers listed were for each study site. The correction was approved by VVC.
- FOIA Request brief overview of requests received from same submitter specific to Starkey and R&D IACUCs(b)(6)
 Respective responses prepared and sent to USFS FOIA liaison. Reminder that good recordkeeping and documentation is essential for any research institution to be prepared for such requests.
- Expiring Terms (May 2020) of 6 IACUC Members Julie, Scott, John, Frank, Pat M.) these member will let the Chair/AV know by January 31st if they will extend their service or will resign at completion of their term.
- IACUC Charter Status the document was signed and is posted on IACUC Intranet and SP sites
- Virtual Facility Inspection Protocol project (b)(6) and Pat K proposed working together with her U Wisconsin colleague who conducts the university animal facility inspections to develop a 'virtual facility inspection' protocol to address our IACUC challenges with remote animal housing in field sites.

2020-004 – Status of Northern Long-Eared Bat on the Ouachita National Forest (Jordan) – Committee discussed
need to reconcile redundant language in several sections of proposal, clarify animal injuries in the emergency
procedures narrative, and include updated references on healing of bat wing tears. Modifications requested
with follow up DMR for final approval (NAM, AV).

- IACUC Members Two members (PSW, NRS) will complete their committee terms in May 2020. The IO will be
 notified to request nominations for their replacements. Further discussions pending with one of the NAMs if
 they will continue on the Committee.

 with completed modifications (vole incidental trap mortality can be included; clarify PPE for equipment
 decon; specify state-required euthanasia of any incidentally trapped non-native species.
