III. NEW BUSINESS:

- A. Review of Animal Use Protocols
 - 1. The following Animal Use Protocols require modifications to secure approval:

 Designated review of modifications per IACUC SOP will occur unless specified otherwise:

Renewal. This protocol is focused on understanding virulence of Brucella, a bacterium that is pathogenic and of concern in the agriculture industry. The committee discussed personnel roles and responsibilities, animal numbers, and safety approval.

Note: Two members with a conflict of interest were recused during the review of this protocol.

- New. This protocol describes whether a facilitated psychotherapy parent support group is an effective method of intervention for parents of children with disabilities and to explore the experiences of parents interacting in a unique treatment environment. The committee discussed personnel roles and responsibilities.
- New. This protocol describes the use of marine habitat and life history information to be used in population management in support of recreational and commercial fishery. The committee discussed animal numbers and euthanasia method.
- Renewal. This protocol describes the use of multiwall carbon nanotubes to induce granulomas in the lung to help elucidate pathways associated with sarcoidosis. The committee discussed procedures and safety approvals.
- Renewal. This protocol describes the use of muscle tissue to study cardiac and skeletal muscle disorders. The committee discussed the 3Rs, housing, and safety approval.



Amendment. This amendment requests a modification of procedure. The committee discussed safety approval.



 New. This protocol describes withdrawal latencies from a specific test before and after treatment with different analyses and a combination thereof.
 The committee discussed administrative changes to be addressed.

Renewal. This protocol describes epithelial tight junctions and their role in kidney and intestinal function and their implication in several hypertension, kidney disease and inflammatory bowel disease. The committee discussed procedures and safety approval.

Renewal. This protocol describes the role of IL-6 signaling in the induction of acute myocardial infarction. The committee discussed procedures.

Renewal. This protocol describes the control of output of spinal cord circuits to devise better management and treatment strategies for nervous system disorders such as restless leg syndrome (RLS) chronic pain, and autonomic dysfunction. The committee discussed procedures.
