Dear Dr. Pipher,

The Office of Laboratory Animal Welfare (OLAW) acknowledges receipt of your April 15, 2019 letter reporting an instance of noncompliance with the PHS Policy on Humane Care and Use of Laboratory Animals at Brown University. According to the information provided, OLAW understands that a live research mouse was found in the carcass refrigerator due to a failure to ensure death following a euthanasia procedure.

The immediate action taken upon discovery consisted of appropriately euthanizing the mouse. No responsible individual could be identified, therefore the two laboratories which could have been involved were notified and staff was retrained. All rodent users will be reminded about the institutional euthanasia policy.

Based on its assessment of this explanation, OLAW understands that measures have been implemented to correct and prevent recurrence of this problem. OLAW concurs with the actions taken by the institution to comply with the PHS Policy.

Dear Dr. Wolff:

The Brown University IACUC, through the Institutional Official (Jill C. Pipher, PhD), is writing to provide OLAW with a final report of the following noncompliance with the *PHS Policy on Humane Care and Use of Laboratory Animals* ("PHS Policy"):

On Monday, March 4th at approximately 9:30 am, an Animal Care Technician (ACT) observed a live mouse within the carcass refrigerator. The mouse was not properly euthanized and was able to escape the untied bag. The ACT humanely euthanized the mouse.

This incident occurred in a lab space shared by multiple investigators. After reaching out to each lab and checking door swipe card access, Animal Care was unable to definitively identify the person responsible.

The IACUC discussed this incident at its convened meeting on April 5th, 2019, and understands that the following corrective actions have taken place:

- Following the event, the PIs of the two labs identified as potentially responsible for the
 incident requested a meeting with the Animal Care staff and the associated lab members
 to discuss the seriousness of the event and a plan to prevent recurrence of this incident.
- Animal Care provided refresher training to both labs on proper euthanasia methods.
- Animal Care will send a notice to all rodent users reminding them of the IACUC approved euthanasia policy.
