

Rabbits were exposed to mustard gas in the eyes at another registered unit then shipped to the University of Missouri to try and experimental treatment. The rabbits were categorized as “E” due to the unknown outcome of the exposure and the effectiveness of treatments. After the first experiment, 20 rabbits, it was determined that the pain and distress can be managed successfully by treatment and subsequent experiments will be conducted at Category D.

Twenty-one ferrets were exposed to influenza virus to test two separate influenza vaccines. Treatment for symptoms was not used in order to determine the effectiveness of the vaccines.
